Deputy Mayor Hendrikx inquired about planning timelines being met at the Township. Clerk/Acting Treasurer Jennifer Turk advised Council that currently there are no issues with meeting the timelines of planning applications.

#### **Staff Reports**

Drainage Superintendent Andrew Neely presented his reports to Council

1) DS-1 Topping Drain – Request

MOVED by Councillor Clarke SECONDED by Deputy Mayor Hendrikx

Resolved that Council accept the request to reconstruct part, or all of the Topping Drain; and that staff be directed to contact all land owners from the most recent assessment schedule for feedback on the scope of work; and that staff be directed to notify the Ausable Bayfield Conservation Authority as per Section 5,1 (b) of the Drainage Act of the Townships intent. CARRIED.

2) DS-2 Knip Ball Drain - Tender Results

Resolved that Council accept the tender from Van Bree Drainage and Bulldozing Limited for the reconstruction of the Knip Ball Drain in the amount of \$74,215 plus HST as recommended by Engineer George Vereyken on behalf of Mike DeVos of Spriet Associates, Drainage Engineer. CARRIED.

Fire Chief Arend Noordhof presented his report to Council.

3) FC-1 Fire Safety Grant March 2021 FC-1 Adelaide Metcalfe - Letter of Intent

Mayor Smith inquired if the \$5,300 grant was to enhance training dollars that are allocated in the 2021 Budget or if the \$5,300 was to offset the training dollars in the approved Budget. Fire Chief Noordhof advised Council that due to the pandemic it is difficult to know how much money will be spent on training for 2021, as it depends on training that is available. Fire Chief Noordhof also advised Council that there are four (4) firefighters signed up to take NAFP 1001 at a fee of \$1,100 each. CAO Morgan Calvert advised Council that the intent of the grant was to enhance or increase monies towards the training program for the fire department.

Resolved that Council receive the Fire Safety Grant – Update Staff Report as presented by the Clerk/Acting Treasurer and that Council approve the Transfer Payment Agreement between the Province of Ontario and the Township of Adelaide Metcalfe for the \$5,300.00 grant allocation to 2021 Training for the Adelaide Metcalfe Fire Department. CARRIED.

Councillor Clarke inquired about the two (2) payments to Southwest Middlesex in the of \$5,200.00 each. Public Works Manager Coulter Cahill advised Council that those payments are for two (2) months for the contract for Drainage Superintendent services.

Councillor MacKinnon inquired about the payments to the County of Middlesex in the amounts of \$81,396.95 and \$16,024.56. CAO Morgan Calvert advised Council that these amounts are for the servicing agreement between Adelaide Metcalfe and County of Middlesex. \$81,396.95 was for the initial agreement from May 15, 2020 to November 15, 2020. The \$16,024.56 was for the three (3) month extension to February 15, 2021.

CAO Morgan Calvert advised Council that during this time-period he was the Acting Township Manager, employed by the County of Middlesex, which poses a bit of a conflict.

Deputy Mayor Hendrikx inquired about the payment to RSM in the amount of \$12,585.42. CAO Morgan Calvert advised Council that this was due to the services of building inspector and is to be divided up amongst the Joint Building Committee (Adelaide Metcalfe, North Middlesex, and Southwest Middlesex). A more comprehensive report would be coming to Council to outline the fees of the Joint Building Services compared to building permit fees that are collected.
