## **BACKGROUND**

Kerwood Park Phase 2 Tender was released on June 10<sup>th</sup>, 2022 and closed on July 7<sup>th</sup>, 2022 with 4 bids submitted.

At the August 8<sup>th</sup> Council Meeting, Council approved the following:

- Issue Tender Award to Frank Van Bussel and Sons Ltd.
- Confirm the Tender from Frank Van Bussel and Sons Ltd. was over budget.
- Direct staff to develop a contract with Frank Van Bussel and Sons Ltd. to eliminate items and to bring back an agreement to complete the works for council's consideration.

# **ANALYSIS**

Staff worked with Spriet Associates to reduce the submitted contract price as recommended by Council at the August 8<sup>th</sup>, 2022 meeting.

By removing the line items outlined in the presentation and bringing some of the smaller projects inhouse, we have developed a strategy that aligns with council's vision and will still stay within our budget.

Spriet Associates issued a Letter of Acceptance based on the reduced scope for the Kerwood Park project (attached). Spriet Associates will be preparing a formal contract for both parties to execute in the amount of \$394,672.98 (plus HST).

Frank Van Bussel and Sons Ltd. Has confirmed they are ready to start construction in September, and plan on completing this contract in the fall weather dependent.
